
- · Increasing access to dialysis on-Country;

- Establishing partnerships with organisations such as Wirraka Maya, Purple House, the Foundation for Indigenous Sustainable Health, and Kidney Health Australia;
- Providing culturally grounded education and support for prevention and care.

This is an opportunity to contribute directly to improving health outcomes for Nyiyaparli people, strengthen culturally safe care, and ensure services are shaped by community voices. The Subcommittee will work alongside the KNAC Board and other partners to advise on governance, implementation, and evaluation of health and wellbeing initiatives.

The Committee will consist of KNAC Member Directors and Nyiyaparli Members who bring lived experience, knowledge of health and wellbeing issues, or strong interest in supporting the community. No previous committee experience is required.
