

KNAC MEMBERS KARLKA PASTORAL ACCESS

What to know before you access Kurtuwa (Ethel Creek), Marillana and Walagunya.

✓ **Notify Pastoral Manager** You MUST notify KNAC Pastoral Manager when you are accessing Kurtuwa (Ethel Creek), Marillana and Walagunya.

✓ **Notify KNAC** If you intend at any time to carry firearms on KNAC pastoral properties, KNAC Member must apply with KNAC for a Standard Hunting Permission.

✓ **Are you on Pastoral Land?** Hunting with firearms is currently permitted if KNAC Member has received a Temporary Hunting Permission in writing via Karlka Pastoral Temporary Hunting Permission Hunting register.

✓ **Follow Firearm safety rules** KNAC Member **MUST** hold a Firearms license. **DO NOT** use a firearm within 2km of homestead, mustering yards, watering point, livestock or near BHP employees or contractors.

✓ **Comply with all laws** KNAC Member complies with all Laws relating to ownership, possession and use of the firearm. The National Firearms Safety Code provided on registration.

✓ **Choose a safe Line of fire** Always ensure safe use of firearms to prevent any property damage, accidents or injury from stray bullets or ricochets.

✓ **Know Pastoral Land Fire rules** Fires must be limited to contained camping and cooking fires. Seek updates of any BHP and government restrictions before igniting.

✓ **Know Pastoral Land camp rules** **DO NOT** camp within 300m of any homestead, shed, mustering yard or watering point without Pastoral Manager permission.



Access is specific to member of Nyiyaparli people who is on the Register of Nyiyaparli People.

Access to Ethel Creek and Marillana is subject to BHP Comprehensive Agreement. Further details relating to access are available in Annexure B Land Access Protocol, available on request.
